Dr. Sandoval will present results from the Harris Cares: Embrace HOPE long COVID study. Dr. Ostrosky-Zeichner will discuss pathophysiology, presentations, clinical features, and outcomes of the patients who experience long COVID that he evaluates at the UTHealth COVID Center of Excellence.
